Humanist Celebrants are well-trained to officiate a wide range of nonreligious wedding ceremonies and vow renewals for any couple wanting to celebrate their

love. The wedding is truly unique – the venue, time, and décor are all up to you. No two weddings are exactly the same, but all of them share a common thread: they embody the values of the couple.

IS A CELEBRANT?

A Humanist Celebrant serves on sole purpose: to provide you with the most authentic, sincere, and poignant start to married life – all without reference to religion. Celebrants can be as involved or uninvolved as you would like. They can help out with all aspects of planning, from writing vows and choosing flowers to picking the venue



and time. Celebrants also serve the role of clergypersons in traditional weddings. They ensure that what matters most to you, your love for one another, is what shines on your wedding day.

IS THE MARRIAGE LEGAL?

In the United States, Humanist Celebrants have all the legal power granted to them that is granted to clergypersons in their respective states. We recommend that all Humanist Celebrants contact local County Clerks to introduce themselves prior to officiating the ceremony.
